

Information on the processing of personal data by Basket Slovanka, z.s.

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

How does it work

Our organization uses eurobasket.cz to obtain contributions to general activities or specific projects of our organization. When entering a contribution through this portal, you enter the amount of the gift and fill in the basic information about yourself. By clicking on the donation button, you will give a promise to provide a donation to our non-profit organization.

As soon as we receive your gift to our bank account, a donation agreement will be concluded between you and our organization.

Legal framework

The rights and obligations in the transfer and processing of personal data in the framework of giving a gift to our organization are regulated by Regulation (EU) No 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data. / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter "GDPR") and other legislation related to personal data protection (GDPR and other personal data protection legislation (hereinafter "OOÚ legislation").

Personal data controller

The administrator of personal data is **Basket Slovanka, z.s., IČ: 48137171,**

(hereinafter also referred to as "organization").

Why we process your personal data

Our organization has the information you enter during the donation process, namely name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number (if filled in), address of residence (if filled in), the amount and frequency of the gift, the method of payment of the gift, which we process from the following legal titles and for the following purposes:

- fulfillment of the contract: the data are necessary for the conclusion and fulfillment of the donation contract between you and our organization (this includes sending a thank-you note for the gift and information on how we used the funds donated by you);
- fulfillment of legal obligations: issuance of a gift certificate applicable in the tax return for deduction, archiving for accounting purposes;
- legitimate interests of the administrator: for the purpose of creating statistics for the internal needs of our organization and archiving in case of disputes, complaints or other claims, for the purposes of donor care, information about donation opportunities and activities of the organization, benefits, etc.

Where we store personal data

We use secure electronic repositories located in the member states of the European Union. This is important because EU countries provide a uniform high level of protection for personal data. This enhances the security of your data.

Retention period of personal data

We archive information about each gift for a period of 3 calendar years from its provision in the event of a complaint, dispute or other claim, unless the law requires a longer archiving period. After the expiration of the said three-year period or any statutory archiving period, we anonymize or delete the provided data.

- for the duration of the contractual relationship (gift contract),
- for a period specified by legal regulations (especially the Accounting Act),
- and for a period of 3 years from the last contact with you, unless you previously request the deletion of data.

Processors and other recipients

We do not sell or otherwise pass on your data to other parti What are your rights?

Under OOO law, you have the right to ask us to provide you with information about your rights as a data subject or to carry out certain operations with personal data. Our organization is responsible for handling requests that relate to personal data processed upon receipt of a gift, as described in this document.

- Right of access and explanation: You have the right to a copy of the personal information we hold about you and to certain information about how we use it.
- Right to correct: If you believe the information we hold about you is inaccurate, you can ask us to update or change it.
- Right to object: You have the right to object to the processing we perform for a legitimate interest. Unless we have a compelling legitimate reason for processing, we will not further process personal data for that purpose.

- Right to data portability: In certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to provide you with your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. You can also request that we pass the data on to a third party.
- Right to delete: In certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to delete your data, for example if personal data is no longer necessary for the original purpose. However, you may not exercise the right of cancellation if the processing is necessary for the fulfillment of an organisation's legal obligation, for the exercise of the right to liberty and of information, and for other reasons provided for by the law of the OOU.
- Right to restrict processing: In certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to stop using your personal data, for example if you think it is inaccurate or if you think it is not necessary for us to continue using your personal data.

Only you or your agent can submit the application. If we are unsure of the applicant's identity, we may ask you for more information to verify your identity.

Our obligation to comply with the request in some cases depends on the purpose for which we process your data. Some rights can only be exercised for certain processing purposes or there are legal exceptions.
